In May we had the trailer repaired and the facilities have been mowed on a regular and frequent basis resulting in a very attractive facility for the Youth Camp. Homeland Security has indicated that they will proceed with the use of our facility for a fee of \$200/day and they are expected to use the ranges 8 days per month starting in August. Members – please note that this will usually be for only 1-2 ranges and will take place from 9:00 AM to 3:PM on week days only so it should not impact the availability of the facilities for member's use. Additionally, this revenue should allow us to make some range improvements that have been discussed for months. Fiscally, we look much better than we have for a couple of years at this time (June 1).
