November found our expenditures in line for this time of year. Overall, expenditures were about \$150 greater than revenues for the month. For the Operating fund, we project expenditures through the rest of the membership year to be between \$4,500 and \$5,500. With a November ending balance of about \$3,800 and an anticipated transfer of approximately \$3,600 from Outreach in December, the operating fund will have a projected cash balance of almost \$2,000 by the end of the membership year.
